- Two bodies were buried

HIGHLIGHTS

Montserratado

- All the ETUs in Montserratado reported today using the new standardized reporting forms
- Of the 25 reported new deaths, 17 were from the ETUs and 8 occurred in communities.

HIGHLIGHTS

Sinoe

- Two contacts that became symptomatic and tested positive are admitted in the holding unit
- The community members accused of attacking the health workers in Unification City, Tarjuowon District will be send to the Sinoe Magisterial Court on Monday
- The DHOs and Supervisors lack Motorcycles

HIGHLIGHTS

Nimba

- 35 gCHVs, with funding from Arcelor Mittal, were trained as contact tracers by the CHSWT and Africare today in Sanniquellie City

HIGHLIGHTS

Lofa

- Three reported deaths:
 - One (1) came from the ETU
 - Two (2) occurred in communities

HIGHLIGHTS

Grand Cape Mount

- Six bodies were buried
- CDDs and gCHVs are now thermo-monitoring passengers at various check points
